Experience Academy is a partnership concern of Shri. Sunil Tukaram Shelgaonkar, Shri. Ravindra G. Salunke and Sau. Aasha Balasaheb Deshmukh owned and run by Shelgaonkar's Unique Career Academy. Having its office at 279, Ramashree', N.C.Kelkar road, Narayan Peth, Pune-30, Experience Academy provides pre-recruitment and competitive examination training cum coaching for UPSC/MPSC/BANK/RAILWAYS/SSC and other competitive examinations for the last 9 years and have a very good name, reputation and goodwill.

Experience Academy has approached to your esteemed college i.e. M. S. Kakade college, Someshwar Nagar, Dist. Pune for making an MOU of running competitive examination related activities at your college campus. You have given the consent for the same. In response Experience academy agreed to provide the facilities to your college as an educational facilitator. The terms of the Experience academy are agreed to and recorded hereunder:

- This MOU does not purport to be a partnership, joint venture, or association of person/body of individual(AOP/BOI)in business but is a MOU between Experience Academy and your college for a period of three years from the date of signing, to be extended by mutual consent.
- Experience Academy agrees to work as an educational facilitator under the name given to the activity clearly mentioning the name of Experience academy with the activity name.
- The territory described above cannot be changed without the prior permissions of either of the party with written consent.
- Making of the course curriculum, course study material, customized question papers and answer sheets, formats required for stationary, content for advertisement, advertisement broacher will be the responsibility of Experience Academy. It will be provided in soft copy only. Hard copies of the material to publish and to distribute are the whole and sole responsibility of your college.
- Selection of the resource persons, delivery of the lectures; seminars; workshop and implementation of the course, engagement of the students in classrooms is whole and sole responsibility of Experience academy. Your college cannot interfere in the training program without prior written permission of Experience academy. Your college authorities can suggest their suggestions as per student's requirement.
- Arrangements of classrooms, function hall for the program, operation of the office, functioning of the office, advertisement of the activities, gathering of students and parents,

arrangements of seminars and workshops, making of the press release and press conferences, media plan etc. is the administrative and financial responsibility of your college.

- Experience Academy will take introductory seminars with no cost for the benefits of the students so that they can understand the nature of competitive examinations and our course structure. (The number of free introductory lectures to be conducted shall be decided by mutual consent.) The conveyance charges shall be payable by your College for these visits.
- To manage the activity between Experience Academy and your college One Coordinator shall be appointed from your college side. Remuneration of the Coordinator is your responsibility. The appointment of the candidate shall be your college's responsibility. The college authority should appoint a local Coordinator from their teaching or non-teaching staff. So that he can regulate the communication with students, principal and Experience Academy
- Depending up on the number of students registered and fees structure mutually decided the Experience Academy shall raise Invoice for each course in the name of your college. The GST as and when applicable shall be charged extra over the invoice amount.
- Experience Academy will provide the Identity Cards to the students clearly mentioning the name of activity with the name of your college and Experience Academy.

Your College must ensure that the students should carry their Identity Cards to the classes.

Experience Academy will conduct following courses at your College campus as:

A) Civil Services Foundation Course (CSFC) – This course will be of six months duration, conducted on weekends (i.e. Saturday and Sunday), completing 10 hrs. of coaching per week. It's a complete 220 to 240 hrs. (Including coaching and test papers) Program comprising 10 subjects essential for various civil services examinations like UPSC, MPSC, BANK, RRB, SSC etc...

The course fees charged per student will be Rs. 11000 only.

B) Short-Term Course For Civil Services (SCCS) – This course will be of 3 months duration conducted on weekends (i.e. Saturday and Sunday), completing 10 hrs. of coaching per week. It's a complete 110 to 120 hrs. (Including coaching and test papers) Program comprising 6 subjects essential for various competitive examinations conducted by MPSC and govt. of Maharashtra.

The course fees charged per student will be Rs. 5500 only.

C) One Month Course For Competitive Examinations (OCCE) - This course will be of 1 month duration conducted on weekends (i.e. Saturday and Sunday), completing 10 hrs. of coaching per week. It's a complete 55 to 60 hrs. (Including coaching and test papers) Program comprising 4 subjects essential for various competitive examinations conducted by gove of Maharashtra.

The course fees charged per student will be Rs. 1500 Only.

- D) Ten days competitive examination orientation program (CEOP) This program will help to nurture the students regarding various career opportunities in civil services and in other fields through motivational speeches and orientation of subject knowledge. It is agreed that this program will take place at the beginning of this Academic year June-July2019-20 and your college will pay Rs. 300 per student considering minimum 600 students involved in the activity. It means that college will give lump sum amount of Rs. 1,80000 (one lakh eighty thousand rupees) to Experience Academy towards organising the resource persons, guests and lectures for all subjects and for all sessions. Your college authority can suggest their suggestions.
- E) It is also agreed that Experience Academy and your College will organize various training and coaching program as per the demand from students regarding preparation of various competitive examinations like BANK, RAILWAYS, MEGA BHARATI, POLICE DHARATI, TALATHI BHARATI, GRAMSEVAK etc.

 miscellaneous inputs by experts and traveling except lodging and boarding.
- Lodging and boarding expenses of the persons coming from Experience Academy shall be borne by Experience Academy in such a manner that visitors will be in comfort zone.
- Your College will bear all the logistics of organizing seminar cum workshop and basic foundation course including stationary, lodging, boarding, advertising and all miscellaneous charges required for running the activities.
- All payments will be drawn by cheques at par favoring * Shelgaonkar's Unique Career Academy*

All disputes arising between the parties to this MOU as to the interpretation, operation of
effect of any cause in this deed or any other differences arising between the signatories, which
cannot be mutually resolved, shall be referred to the arbitrator.
